## "The Orchestral Harpsichord" Bach Handel, Babell, Geminiani

The nineteenth century tradition of reducing orchestral pieces to a keyboard rendition did not start then; it was a tradition already practiced with choral pieces in the 16<sup>th</sup> century. Bach admired Vivaldi and transcribed many of Vivaldi's orchestral works and Handel's Water-music was published as pieces for harpsichord. Renditions of operatic arias were even performed on keyboard!
